## What happens?

- I. Closing (the property is sold to the partnership)
- 2. Allied Orion Group begins management of the community at closing.
- 3. Current leases terminate and you will be asked to sign a new lease
- 4. You will have an appointment to certify you for the tax credit program I. You will not be rescreened
- The Housing Authority will redetermine your rent and will send you a notification of your new rent amount.
- 6. You will be notified when your home is going to be renovated and the construction schedule.
- 7. You will work with the relocation specialist to determine the best relocation options for your family and the time frame.
- 8. You will move to your temporary home.
- 9. You may need to execute a new lease/ change utilities and more.
- 10. You will move to your permanent home.
